Monday, July 15 9 am to Noon Peer Supervision Maria Bowen, PhD

In this half-day session, we will learn and practice a simple model of peer supervision so that we can continue to support each other in our various spiritual care ministries. Our morning together is intended to launch voluntary support groups that will continue meeting through the year, either face-to-face or electronically.

Maria Bowen, PhD, is a co-founder of Together in the Mystery, a hybrid program for preparing spiritual directors for the added ministry of supervision. She also serves on the faculty of the Diploma in the Art of Spiritual Direction at San Francisco Theological Seminary where she teaches Fundamentals of Spiritual Direction. For many years, she organized and oversaw the supervision of that program's spiritual directors in training.
